Day01 Sunday, Aug.31

Depart Wilkes Barre & Scranton for the Newark Int'l Airport Fly Non-stop from Newark to Rome

Day02 Monday, Sept.01

Morning arrival and transfer with your private deluxe motorcoach to the eternal city of **Roma**, built on 7 hills in the middle of an undulating plain. This marble city was created by Augustus and, according to legend, was founded by Romulus in 753 B.C. and by many considered the cradle of Western Civilization and the heart of Catholicism. Prior to arrival at hotel (check-in time after 3 pm) celebrate **mass with Bishop Bambera at Basilica of St. Paul outside the walls Welcome dinner** at local restaurant

Day03 Tuesday, Sept.02

After breakfast you will have the unique opportunity to participate in rarely experience visit to the **SCAVI** -guided tour of the necropolis under St. Peter's Basilica, culminating at the tomb of St. Peter. (arranged by Msgr. Washington),

Following Mass at St. Mary Major (Papal Basilica Maria Maggiore),

After lunch break (optional) your afternoon tour - Basilica St. John Lateran - Coliseum (outside visit) – walking tour Rome - Dinner at hotel BD

Day04 Wednesday, Sept.03

Papal Audience

Early morning transfer to the Vatican –

07:00 am Mass with Bishop Bambera

Afterwards get seated for the **Papal Audience**. After lunch (on own) enjoy the remainder of the day for individual activities. Dinner on your own

Day05 Thursday, Sept.04

on the way to Assisi we have **Mass** at the famous **Basilica of Santa Maria degli Angeli** housing the **Portiuncula**, the "little church that St. Francis built," the thorn-less rose bush, and the ever present doves at the cave where St. Francis retired for prayer.

We continue to the magical and enchanting town of Assisi, home of St. Francis and St. Clare, surrounded by its ancient walls, spread over the green slopes of Mount Subasio with its colorful houses of pink stone, narrow streets and flower-decked balconies. Visit the Basilica of San Francesco to view the cycle of Giotto's frescos with its twenty eight episodes from the life of St. Francis. Visit the Church of St. Clare housing the incorrupt body of St. Clare and the Cross of San Damiano which spoke to Francis telling him to "build my church." Remainder of the day at leisure to stroll the winding streets and discover the peace that still remains in this small village. Dinner and overnight in Assisi.

Day06 Friday, Sept.05

08:00 AM Mass at the tomb of St. Francis.

Morning departure, we continue leisurely north through hilly countryside dotted with Chianti vineyards and olive groves to old Siena, the best preserved medieval town in Italy. Visit the Cathedral with frescos by Pinturicchio and the pulpit by Nicola Pisano. Visit St. Dominic Church which houses the incorrupt body of St. Catherine of Siena, doctor of the Church. St. Catherine's letters are considered among the most brilliant writings in the history of the Catholic Church. Not to be missed is the famous shell shaped Piazza del Campo where the famous Palio (annual 75 second flag-waving horse race) is held every summer.

Arrive at the spa town of Montecatini Terme for dinner at hotel

Day07 Saturday, Sept.06

Morning mass at Basilica Santa Maria Assunta

After breakfast departure to Florence - the "Cradle of the Renaissance" Your guided city tour includes the Cathedral with its immense cupola by Brunelleshi, the Bell Tower by Giotto, the "Door of Paradise" by Ghiberti, and other historical masterpieces. Sufficient time to visit the jewelry shops and leather workshops on the Ponte Vecchio for some serious shopping and individual lunch break. Late afternoon return to Montecatini Terme.

You might take the historic funicular up to Montecatini Alto (great view over Tuscany good restaurants at the piazza!) Dinner on your own В

Day08 Sunday, Sept.07

Drive through the beautiful Tuscany countryside to the city of LUCCA – one of the Italian's "Città d'arte" (Art towns) with a very well preserved historic center – visit Piazza dell'Anfiteatro and Guinigli Tower, a 45-metre tall tower that dates from the 1300s. The whole city is surrounded by enormous city walls.

10:00 am Mass at the cathedral of S. Martino. Continue to the winery "Fattoria il Poggio" in Montecarlo for a light Tuscan lunch and wine tasting.

Day09 Monday, Sept.08

Depart south along the freeway – along the shores of Lago Trasimeno – Perugia to Gubbio, Located on the slope of Mt. Ingino and Sister City of Jessup, PA. This ancient pre-Roman town is famous for the discovery of the Eugabine Tablets, a set of bronze tablets featuring the largest surviving text in ancient Umbria. After arrival at Gubbio Duomo celebrate mass with Bishop Bambera.

Lunch at Tayerna del Lupo. In the afternoon continue south direction Rome. light dinner at your BLD Rome airport hotel

Day10 Tuesday, Sept.09

Early morning departure to Rome Airport for USA / Newark flight. В Arrival Newark, transfer back to Wilkes Barre & Scranton. (Welcome Home!)
