From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

One goal of mine as your pastor is to be transparent when it comes to the finances of St Rose & Our Lady of Mount Carmel. Each year I will provide you – with the help of the Finance Councils and Fr. Mosley – with a general end-of-year report on the operations of our great parishes, so that you can see how your contributions are used to run these parishes. This State of the Parish Report highlights some events that have happened over this past year, and some that will take place as we move forward this year. On the back page you will find then income and expenses we had here at the parishes from July 1,2022 to June 30, 2023.

The revenue is rather straight forward, collections and fundraising make up most of our income here. The expenses, on the other hand, are more diverse. The expense of the upkeep of the buildings along with the running of the office make up almost half of our expenses. Almost 30% of the revenue goes back to the Diocese of Scranton in assessments that are given to all diocesan parishes. Cathedraticum is an assessment to help run the diocese and its offices. The School Assessment is again given to all parishes in the Diocese of Scranton to help finance the Catholic School System and keep it running along with the tuition they charge.

We had a deficit of about \$34,000 at Our Lady of Mount Carmel and a surplus of \$1,000 at St Rose. This report illustrates

again the need for us to work together and to support one another in our Mission here in Carbondale. We have cut many expenses over this past year in the office and around the buildings, but we are still projecting a shortfall for the upcoming year. I thank you for all your generosity from the bottom of my heart. As we look to this new fiscal year, I ask you to please consider your ongoing support to St. Rose and Our Lady of Mount Carmel so we can continue so serve the great people of this community.

This last year we accomplished a lot together. As you know this upcoming year will be a year of transition, and I ask for your patience and prayers as we continue to walk this journey of faith together here in the 18407; continuing to Build Disciples and Share Love. Once again, thank you for all that you do and give to St. Rose & Our Lady of Mount Carmel.
