Parish Faith Formation Grant *Criteria and Guidelines*

Application Deadline: May 9, 2025

Grant amount: \$250-\$5,000

Funds used for: Family Faith Formation Initiatives, Adult Faith Formation Initiatives, Youth Ministry Initiatives, Child Faith Formation Initiatives, Evangelization Initiatives

The Parish Faith Formation Grant is in service of the Mission of the Diocese of Scranton.

We, the Catholic community of the Diocese of Scranton, are called through Baptism to imitate the servant leadership of Jesus Christ. In union with our Holy Father, the Pope, we proclaim the Gospel faithfully, celebrate the sacraments joyfully, and boldly promote life, justice and peace in northeastern and northcentral Pennsylvania.

To be considered for the grant, a parish must submit an initiative that demonstrates an effort to equip missionary disciples:

- To live our faith fully
- To share our faith freely with others
- To transform the world in Christ
- To call forth the baptized to assume positions of servant leadership; and,
- To foster the spirit of co-responsibility – supporting each parish in its unique journey to becoming a fully participative community of living faith.

Funding Priorities

Priority of funds through the Parish Faith Formation Grant encourage:

- Faith formation initiatives that are in collaboration with neighboring parishes
- Faith formation initiatives that reach a wide audience
- Sustainable initiatives that can continue when funding ends
- New or creative faith formation initiatives
- Projects or events that align with the mission of the Diocese

Eligibility

To be eligible for the Diocese of Scranton Parish Faith Formation Grant, your parish must be one of the 106 parishes within the Diocese of Scranton, with a focus on at least one of the following:

- Promoting life-long discipleship formation and activities
- Inviting and welcoming home Catholics and non-Catholics into the parish
- Providing spiritual support to families, singles, youth and young adults
- Using updated technology and media to grow faith formation events



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Ineligibility

Applications will be deemed ineligible and therefore not awarded a grant:

- Initiatives that are outside the scope of the grant's priorities
- Existing staff salaries
- Capital campaigns or projects
- Already completed projects
- Initiatives that cannot prove to be self-sustaining
- Emergency funds

Funding Opportunities

Parishes are encouraged to focus on initiatives that foster a sense of belonging and community, based on the current model of "Belong – Believe – Behave". Initiatives for families, adults, youth and children may be considered. Additionally, parishes are encouraged to look at ways in which to deepen the faith of active adult parishioners and equip them to reach out to inactive Catholics.

How to Apply

Please review the objectives and funding priorities and prayerfully consider if your initiative aligns with these objectives. If so, you may fill out the electronic application and submit it to Marianne Guarnieri, Diocesan Director of Discipleship, at mguarnieri@dioceseofscranton.org, before the deadline of May 9, 2025.

Awarding

The applications for the Parish Faith Formation Grant will be reviewed by a committee during the month of May 2025. Recipients of the Parish Faith Formation Grant will be notified in June 2025 and will be awarded the funds in July 2025.

***Please note:** *If your parish is awarded the Parish Faith Formation Grant you will be required to submit a mid-year and end of year report, detailing how the grant was used to promote life-long formation within your parish.*
